The Archives contains unique and irreplaceable documents which reflect the history of Dundas and the lives of its citizens. This material includes:

- Records of individuals, businesses, and organizations.
- Records of the Town of Dundas.
- Photographs and maps.
- Scrapbooks and newspapers.
- Sheet music, greeting, and advertising cards.
- Postcards, posters.

The Archives also maintains a non-circulating Reference Collection which includes a Library, Subject Files, Family Files, and the Woodhouse Family History Collection.
